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PAYMENT OF ANNUAL MAINTENANCE FEES – A POLICY CHANGE

The AAHP Executive Committee has approved a policy change regarding the **payment of annual maintenance fees** for the maintenance of certification. This change was communicated to the membership in an e-mail dated 30 July 2018.

The new policy:

- Requires that maintenance fees be paid annually, with the option to delay payment until recertification eliminated
- Invoicing will be for the upcoming year rather than the preceding year
- Members who have not paid by February 2019 (for the calendar year 2019) will be sent a single reminder letter. After April 2019, the member will be REMOVED FROM THE ACADEMY ROSTER and must DISCONTINUE THE USE OF THE CHP DESIGNATION.
- Reinstatement is possible and involves additional fees
- The policy change brings the Academy in-line with generally accepted accounting practices and with other similar professional organizations
